We have recently been telling you about the blue offering envelopes as an easy way to give to church. Another easy way you can give is by setting up a Standing Order or Direct Debit with your bank. For those who are not internet savvy, we have Standing Order forms available (some on the post table or just ask for one)

and once filled in giving your bank details and the amount and frequency you would like to give, return it to the office and we do the rest for you. For those who do internet banking, again setting up a direct debit is easy, our sort code at TSB is 30-93-75 and the account number is 00331844, just put TITHE as your reference - as easy as that! If you currently pay tax and haven't already completed a Gift Aid form, again there are some on the post table or just ask us for one, then for each £1 you give, the Government will add 25p at no extra cost to you.
