## Activities to do:

- Go on your own leaf hunt to collect colourful leaves you could even create your own leaf kebab using leaves and a stick!
- Create large patterns with your found leaves outdoors, like our artist of the week - Andy Goldsworthy (picture below).



Encourage your child to experiment with paint, creating handprints. When they are comfortable with putting their hands in paint, encourage them to take off their socks and dip their feet in the paint and create footprints on large paper.



Help your child to create a route, using maybe train or Happy Street track or even just blocks.



Help your child to create a large obstacle course outdoors using anything that you can find for them to climb over, crawl under or through or that they can use as stepping-stones. As they move across the equipment, talk to them about the route that they are taking.
