## Activities to do:

\* Set up a small world road for your child to engage with, perhaps draw a road on some large paper or cut strips of paper that your child can create their own road system with. Draw a zebra crossing on the road. When your child is pushing the cars around and they get to the zebra crossing, encourage them to stop the cars to allow the people to cross the road.



Find a variety of different sized items around the house and talk to your child about which is longest and shortest. They could even have a go at ordering them by length, longest first and then the shortest last. If you have some small building blocks, they could place a row of blocks next to the item to measure how big it is. Lay them down and then count them to find out how many blocks long the item is.
