- Working on noticing initial sounds and alliteration, focusing on the 'mmm' sound



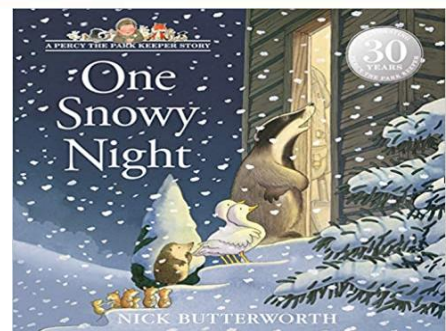
- Learning how to fix together a variety of shaped boxes and containers to create houses

- Exploring our Happy Street small world



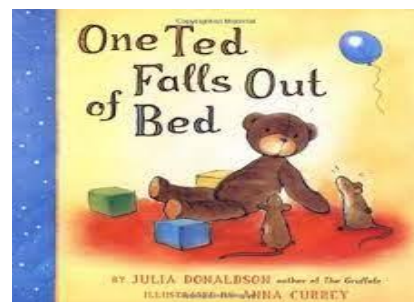
- Building with large blocks outdoors

Working Together to Extend your Child's Learning at Home

As we work in partnership with parents/carers we ask that you continue to enhance your child's learning and development this week through sharing and exploring with some or all of the following activities which you can enjoy together:

- ➔ Share stories with your child, discuss their favourite story and chat about how stories are structured, the beginning, middle and end and talk about the characters involved. Can your child independently recall the basic story to you?
- ➔ Encourage your child to experiment with different ways of moving, such as slithering, shuffling, rolling, crawling, walking, running, jumping, skipping, sliding and hopping.
- ➔ Draw your child's attention to rhyming words in stories and in conversation. Encourage them to create nonsense rhyming strings.
